

## **CRS 12-55-110.5 Signature by Proxy**

CRS 12-55-110.5 provides a procedure for notarizing for a person (the principal) with a physical limitation or disability. If the principal is aware and willing to sign, but unable to sign, due to a physical limitation or disability, the principal may appoint another person, not the notary, as their agent, to sign for the disabled person.

The appointed agent must sign the principal's name, at the direction and in the presence of the principal, and in the presence of the notary. Under or near the signature, the following words shall appear:

"Signature written by (Agent's Name)  
at the direction and in the presence of (Name as signed),  
on whose behalf the signature was written."
